

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PROMOTION „WINTER COLOURS”

I. GENERAL TERMS

§ 1

These terms and conditions specify the rules of the „WINTER COLOURS”, hereinafter referred to as the „Promotion”.

§ 2

§ 3

II. THE CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN PROMOTION

§ 4
